Procedures for Classroom

1. Respect others.
2. Be prepared.
 - Be in the class when the bell rings.
 - Be in your seat and prepared to rehearse with all of your materials at the beginning of class. This includes your binder and a pencil.
 - Create a plan to keep track of deadlines, events, and activities.
3. Follow directions the first time.
4. Do your best—give 100% ALL of the time.

Grading

Each 9 weeks:

- 35% Professionalism-You will receive one professionalism grade for each week, which will reflect your attitude, preparedness, and performance for that week.
- 20% Classwork (tests, quizzes, worksheets, etc.)
- 45% Concert Performance

Supplies

You will need a pencil (**NOT A PEN**) is every day.
You will purchase a T-shirt to wear for field trips and for school concerts.
Water bottles are encouraged as long as they follow school guidelines.

T Shirts

We will be ordering chorus T-shirts that will be worn for field trips and in-school concerts.

T-shirts will be \$10 and the due date is August 31.

Concerts

All concerts are mandatory and are GRADED events.

Having an unexcused absence for a concert will result in a **ZERO** for that performance grade. Because we don't have many performances during a 9 weeks, **that ZERO will greatly affect your grade for the class.**

Missing 2 concerts in one year will result in being removed from chorus.

What to wear:

YOU MUST BE IN DRESS CODE AT ALL TIMES!

For evening performances: All clothing and shoes should be solid black. No writing or designs should be visible to the audience.

For field trips and performances during the school day: Students should wear their chorus t-shirt and blue jeans or khaki pants or shorts.

If you aren't prepared with the correct clothing or if it's not dress code, you will not perform.
