### **Information for Enrolling Homeschool Students**



If you have child who has been enrolled in a home school and you are wishing to enroll at TWH for the 2021-2022 School year, please review the steps outlined below. If you were enrolled in Sumner County Virtual School last year, that is not homeschool and you will not need to follow these steps. Students from Sumner County Virtual will attend registration nights as usual.

Steps for enrolling at TWH from a homeschool setting:

- Attend new student registration on July 21st with all the appropriate documents which can be found on our website: [twh.sumnerschools.org](http://twh.sumnerschools.org).
- The student or students enrolling will be given a Math and an ELA assessment during this time that covers the standards of the most recently completed grade level.
- Parents will complete new student registration while students complete their assessments. Registration should only take 15-30 minutes, but it could take an hour or two for the completion of the assessments.
- You will still attend our Buc-N-Roll registration night depending on your child's grade.
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Graders: Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 – 6:45pm
  - 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Graders: Tuesday, July 27<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 – 6:45pm
